



Every Monday we have a grand round and post operative radiology meeting in which all the post op cases were discussed in detail. Dr. Henry Fu critically analyzed every case and very professionally he involves his all team members in the discussion.

On Tuesday we have pre operative meeting in which specialist present cases one by one, Dr. Henry Fu, Dr. Lewis Chan and Dr. Amy Cheung give suggestions regarding surgical plan and implant options. In the outpatient clinic I was able to see different varieties of cases with long term follow up.

The division has two OT days in DKCH and Two OT days in QMH per week.
